This is a Regional Grading and it ought to be attended by all regardless of rank and irrespective whether you yourself are testing. Black Belts will be called on for demonstrations and it's important for All members to be familiar with Grading Protocol. Take this opportunity to meet the Wider Taekwon-Do Community in your Region. If you are testing, you will already have made arrangements with your Instructor to submit fees and your Membership Book.

Black Belts are invited to the Grading Dinner following and this event will be Full Formal. Again, as Seniors, the onus is on Us to ensure we can observe Formal Protocol in the company of our Seniors and as such, this is a continuation of our own Training, keeping in mind that Master Moore will be in attendance at the next Gup/Dan Grading and Seminar in August.
